



We are an all volunteer, 501(c)(3) organization incorporated in 1963, as the Columbiana County Forest and Parks Council. Although our name has changed to Friends of Beaver Creek State Park, along with faces over these many years, the organization's core ambition has remained unchanged and is echoed in our mission statement:

"The association is devoted to the development, growth and preservation of the Pioneer Village. Our mission is to educate the public and develop a base of appreciation for local history while providing opportunity for recreation and family enjoyment".
